Probate Application Processing by Video

- 1. Complete the probate application: <u>https://www.norfolkcircuitcourt.us/wp-</u> <u>content/uploads/2018/05/APPLICATION-FOR-PROBATE-</u> <u>APPOINTMENT.pdf</u>
- 2. If there is a will, you will need to mail the original will along with the completed probate application and the death certificate to this office prior to setting your video appointment.
- 3. Send the completed and signed application along with a copy of both parties id to <u>probate710@circuitcourtva.us</u> or mail it along with the will, if there is one.
- 4. Include your preferred email address for communications
- 5. Once the Clerk's office receives the application, will and death certificate, we will process and mail you the documents that will need to be signed before a Clerk during your video calls. The Clerk's Office staff will send you a link to a video call
- 6. The video call will include:
 - a. the parties viewable on camera
 - b. Holding your ID up to the camera so that we can verify you against the documents presented
 - c. Swearing your oath
 - d. You will need to have a valid credit card to complete the payment of fees
- Once the above steps are completed, you will mail all original documents signed during your video call to this office at Norfolk Circuit Court Attn: Probate, 150 St. Paul's Blvd. 7th Floor, Norfolk, VA 23510.
- 8. Upon receiving original signed documents, we will issue and mail out to you your Qualification Certificates and probate package.
- If you do not have access to a camera on your laptop/computer or phone, you will have to schedule an appointment after March 31, 2020, providing the closure of city offices is lifted.
